

**Corrections:** In the article, “Sex Steroid Regulation of the Inflammatory Response: Sympathoadrenal Dependence in the Female Rat,” by P. G. Green, S. R. Dahlqvist, W. M. Isenberg, H. J. Strausbaugh, F. J.-P. Miao, and J. D. Levine, which appeared on pages 4082–4089 of the May 15, 1999 issue, on page 4085, the last sentence of the first paragraph under the heading Effects of hormone administration should read, “In contrast, gonadectomized males implanted with  $17\beta$ -estradiol had a BK-induced PE significantly different from that produced in males that were only gonadectomized.” Also on page 4085, in the legend to Figure 4, “dihydrotestosterone” should read “testosterone.”
