Subscriptions are on a volume basis beginning with the January 4 issue. The Volume 26 (2006) institutional rate for the on-line only edition is \$2370. The institutional rate for the print and on-line edition is \$2608 (plus shipping). Single copies for the U.S. are \$105, \$120 elsewhere.
