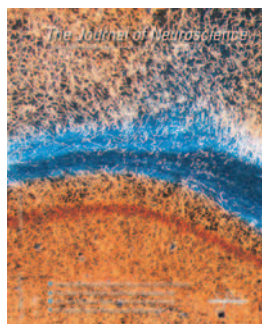

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**Corrections:** In the article “Pronounced Reduction of Digit Motor Responses Evoked from Macaque Ventral Premotor Cortex after Reversible Inactivation of the Primary Motor Cortex Hand Area” by Eric Schmidlin, Thomas Brochier, Marc A. Maier, Peter A. Kirkwood, and Roger N. Lemon, which appeared on pages 5772–5783 of the May 28, 2008 issue, the authors acknowledge that the use of Antisedan should be  $0.05 \text{ mg/kg}^{-1}$  per dose instead of  $0.8 \text{ mg/kg}^{-1}$ , and the total volume injected per penetration of muscimol is  $7.5 \mu\text{g}$  per injection (3 sites) instead of  $0.25 \mu\text{g}$ .

In the article “Novel Role for Vascular Endothelial Growth Factor (VEGF) Receptor-1 and Its Ligand VEGF-B in Motor Neuron Degeneration” by Koen Poesen, Diether Lambrechts, Philip Van Damme, Joke Dhondt, Florian Bender, Nicolas Frank, Elke Bogaert, Bart Claes, Line Heylen, An Verheyen, Katrien Raes, Marc Tjwa, Ulf Eriksson, Masabumi Shibuya, Rony Nuydens, Ludo Van Den Bosch, Theo Meert, Rudi D’Hooge, Michael Sendtner, Wim Robberecht, and Peter Carmeliet, which appeared on pages 10451–10459 of the October 15, 2008 issue, the authors acknowledge that when referring to the  $10 \mu\text{g}$  of VEGF-B in the osmotic minipumps implanted into the SOD1 rats, they made an error in the calculation in the concentrations of VEGF-B delivered per day and per kilogram of body weight. The  $10 \mu\text{g}$  of VEGF-B corresponds to  $2 \mu\text{g/kg/d}$  and not to  $0.2 \mu\text{g/kg/d}$ , as incorrectly mentioned throughout the manuscript.

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
