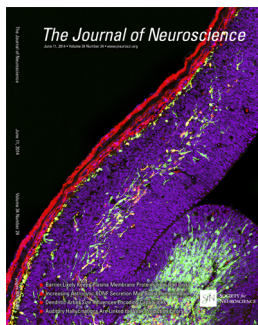


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Cover legend: Confocal image of a fluorescently labeled tissue section prepared from an embryonic day 13.5 mouse brain. Most migratory interneurons in the developing cerebral cortex express GFP (green) and calbindin (red). Nuclei are counterstained with Draq5 (purple).
