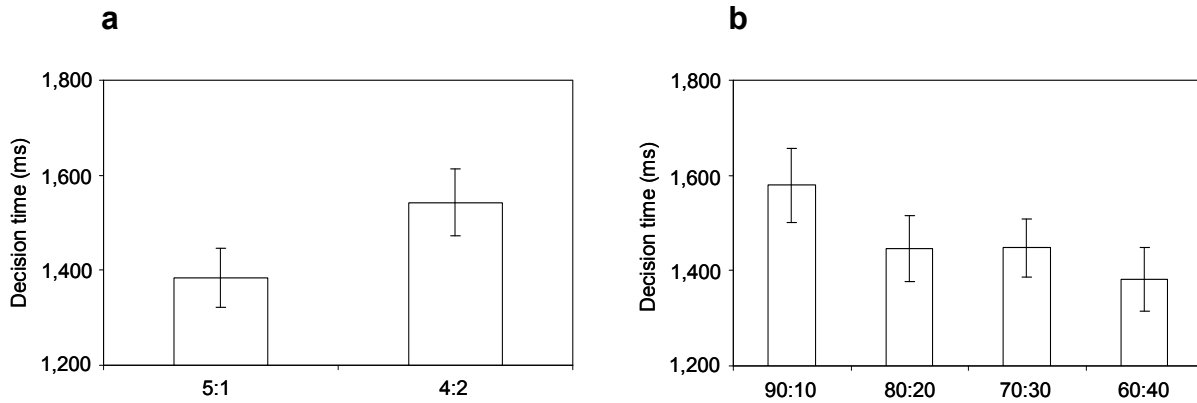


Figure 2 shows results on decision times (means \pm SEM). ANOVA of group \times level of risk \times balance of reward, for the decision times revealed no main effect for group ($F(2,24) = 0.31$; $p = 0.737$), but **(a)** a significant main effect for level of risk ($F(1,24) = 30.17$; $p < 0.001$). Subjects decided faster when confronted with the 5:1 scenario compared to the 4:2 scenario. **(b)** There was also a significant main effect for balance of reward ($F(3,72) = 11.70$; $p < 0.001$). Subjects decided significantly faster when confronted with the 60:40 balance of reward compared to 90:10 ($p < 0.002$).
