Figure legend

Figure 1S: Percent of high probability choices across the learning session in participants classified as “non-learners”. These participants showed no increase in the choice of the high probability action over training although they wanted the associated rewards. 1 block = 15 trials. Data represent means \pm standard errors of the mean.
