



Supplemental Figure 1. Contrast detection threshold data without normalization.

Same data as in Figure 4c, but without subtracting the mean contrast detection threshold value from the data of each subject. Note that the shape of the function is identical, but that the non-normalized data has much larger error bars because of between subject variability in overall contrast detection thresholds. However, since we are only concerned with the shape of the function, and all relevant comparisons are within-subject, then we present the normalized data in the main text to remove this between-subjects source of variance. All error bars are ± 1 S.E.M.
